#### **First-Aider information**

Stonesfield Strikers FC managers hold a FA Emergency First Aid Certificate (as a minimum). They will be able to assist with a medical emergency. Please locate the nearest Stonesfield Strikers manager should you require assistance.

#### **First Aid Equipment/Facilities**

Defibrillator:	A Defibrillator is located outside of the Burditch Hall Entrance (Burditch Hall is on-site at the Wootton Memorial Playing Field). Instructions for its use are on the Defibrillator door.
First Aid:	Team Managers Medical Bag.

#### **Access Routes:**

For Ambulance: Via main vehicle entrance to the Wootton Memorial Playing Field.

Directions to Hospital from OX20 1EG, Wootton Memorial Playing Field, Castle Road, Wootton by Woodstock, Oxon. Turn right from main entrance north on Castle Road. At T-Junction turn Right on to B4027. Follow B4027 to T-Junction and turn Right onto the A4260 towards Kidlington/Oxford. Continue on this road through Kidlington until you reach a large roundabout (passing Sainsbury Supermarket on your left) at approximately 6.8 miles. Take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit at this roundabout on to the A4165 Oxford road. Continue until you reach the next roundabout and take the first exit on to the A40. Exit the A40 towards Marston (exit signposted JR Hospital). Follow Marsh Lane/B4150 to traffic lights and turn left on to Cherwell Drive/B4495. Proceed up the hill (Headley Way) and turn left at traffic lights (signposted JR Hospital). Follow Hospital on-site signs for A&E.

Journey Time 27 mins (approx. 12miles)
